WHAT TO DO IF YOUR **FURNACE WON'T START...**

1. Check your Thermostat

Set the thermostat 5° above the room temperature. If it is a clock thermostat, make sure the time is correct (AM or PM).

2. Check Electric Switches

Make certain that the stair switch is in the ON position and also check switches next to furnace or boiler.

3. Check Reset Button

Press the red reset button on a gray box. Location of the gray box could be in the flue pipe, on the burner or in front of boiler. Caution, press this button once only! If the burner still does not start, press a red button located on the burner motor.

4. Examine Fuses or Breakers

Make sure the fuse is not loose or burned. Switch breaker off and then on again.

5. Is boiler water level O.K.? (steam only)

Make sure water level is half way up gauge glass. If the level is low, open the water feed valve until correct level is restored. Then close valve tightly.

6. Check your Oil Tank

Be sure there is oil in the tank and oil line valve is open.
